THE REPORT'S OBJECTIVES

- GDA did not distribute £350,000 in land compensation to farmers in a timely manner and the amount remained idle in the authority's coffers. The authority could have accrued interest on the sum had it made some financial investment, the report states
- £207 or it not recovered on plots facing parks and along 18 mile - side roads
- It missed out on case cost of £432 or
- £203,333 or in fees also not collected for the Horden Elected Road project
- It is calculating compound interest lost GDA another £333,124
- Report says £621,111 or losses under other revenue generation roads

The report's objectives are to identify areas where the authority could have improved its financial performance. It highlights several areas where the authority has lost money, including:

- Not distributing £350,000 in land compensation to farmers in a timely manner.
- Missing out on case cost of £432 or.
- Not collecting £203,333 or in fees for the Horden Elected Road project.
- Missing out on compound interest lost GDA another £333,124.
- Report says £621,111 or losses under other revenue generation roads.

The report also identifies areas where the authority has saved money, including:

- £390,000 or in 2017-18.
- £2,392,000 or in 2016-17.

The report concludes that the authority has a significant opportunity to improve its financial performance by addressing these areas.
